

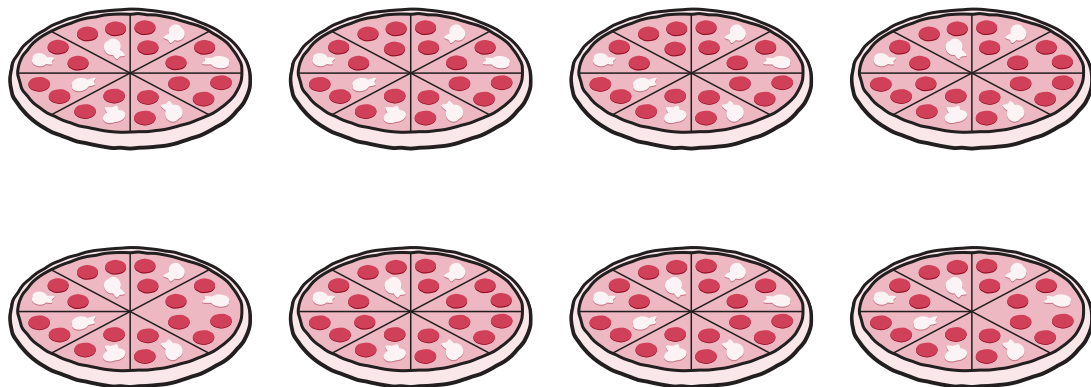

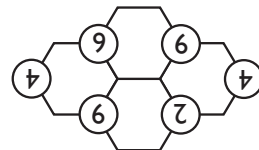

Fill in the board so that the numbers 1 through 9 appear only once in each row, column and 3 x 3 box.

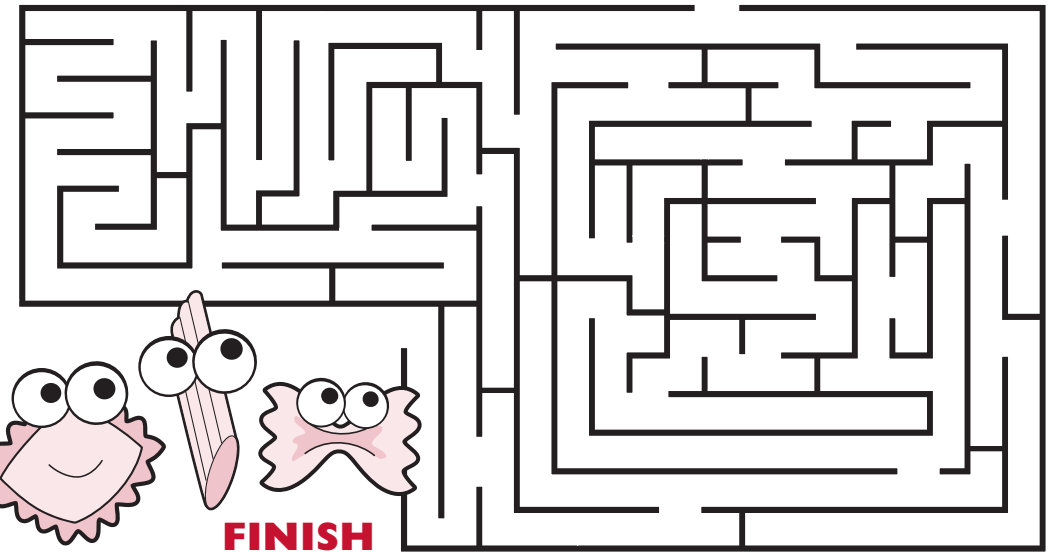

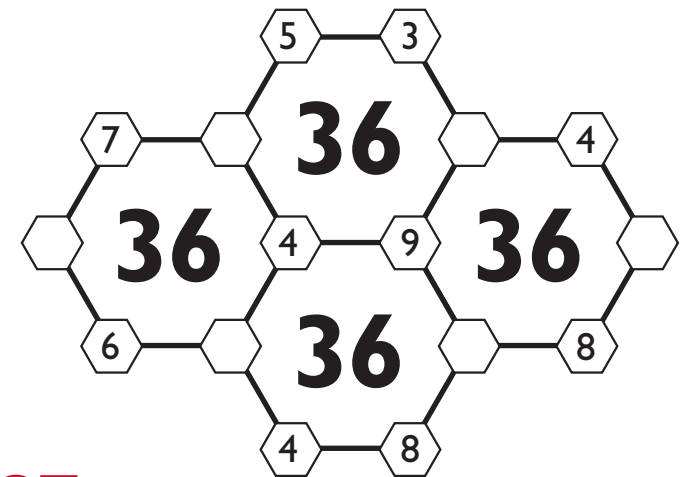
## A MAZE-ING MACARONI
